

# The Greatest Question in the World

## What Shall I Do With Jesus?

This question was asked by Pilate, and comes to you, reader, with all its force and reality.

"Pilate said to them (the crowd) 'Then what shall I do with Jesus who is called Christ?'"

**Did it ever occur to you that this question must be answered by every individual – including kings, rulers and nations?**

We must answer it as individuals, because God has proved the whole world guilty – both Jew and Gentile (Romans 3v9). "That every mouth may be stopped, and the whole world may be held accountable to God"(Romans 3v19).

We must answer this question as individuals, because the Father has provided in His Son a Saviour for those whom he has proved guilty. **"For God so loved the world that he gave his only son that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life"(John 3v16).**

The Lord Jesus Christ at the cross met every just and holy claim God had against sin and the sinner; "He was wounded for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities... All we, like sheep, have gone astray, we have turned every one to his own way; and the Lord has laid on Him the iniquity of us all" (Isaiah 53v5,6).

The work of redemption was finished at the cross. The great sin question was settled. It is now the SON question– What will you do with this Man, Who is called Christ?

There is no getting away from this. You had better plead guilty to the charges that are against you and have this matter settled.

There is pardon for the guilty. You may meet Christ **NOW** as your Saviour; or meet Him after **DEATH** as your Judge. "It is appointed for man to die once, and after that comes

judgement"(Hebrews 9v27). He (God) has appointed a day in which He will judge the world in righteousness, BY that Man whom He hath ordained.

### What Will You Do With Jesus?

The above question does not mean, have you been baptized? Have you joined the church? Are you doing the best you can? Are you sincere? Have you accepted a certain doctrine or creed?

No, it is a Divine Living Person, the SON OF GOD that is before you. The One Who said, **"I am the Way, and the Truth and the Life. No one comes to the Father except through me"(John 14v6).**

Reader, have you received the Lord Jesus Christ as your own personal Saviour? Are you trusting in His shed BLOOD and work on the cross ALONE for salvation? Or are you depending on what you are in yourself? Are you trusting in your so-called good works, morality, and on what you think you are doing for God? Which do you think God will accept – your so-called good works and what you think you are doing for Him; or Christ's work for you and what He has done for you? The all-important question is: Have you accepted God's remedy in providing a Saviour for lost and guilty sinners?

**"But to all who did receive Him(Christ), who believed in His Name, he gave the right to become children of God"(John 1v12).**

God will sooner or later bring every individual, as well as nation, to a strict account of their treatment of His Son.
