*Musick Fyne* Vocal performers from Inverness, Ross-shire and Moray who take their name from the term used in 16th-century Scotland to denote serious music. Since 1980 they have performed the neglected music of this period throughout Scotland.

*Animato String Quartet* A well known group, performing regularly at private functions and concerts in the area. These 4 talented musicians delight in bringing their individuality and charm to each performance. From Baroque to Beatles, they promise a unique string quartet experience.



*Merlewood Ensemble* Established for 7 years, this versatile chamber ensemble enjoy performing a varied repertoire of classical music for strings, woodwind and keyboard throughout the Highlands.

*Julie Keen* Julie trained under Margaret Aronson in Edinburgh and performed and recorded with several choirs in the 'central belt' before moving to Inverness. She enjoys performing a variety of musical styles and has sung and recorded as soloist with the New Scottish Singers in Glasgow.



*Salvation Army Timbrel Players* A group who perform at Salvation Army Conferences displaying synchronized routines, providing a palette of rhythm and music.
