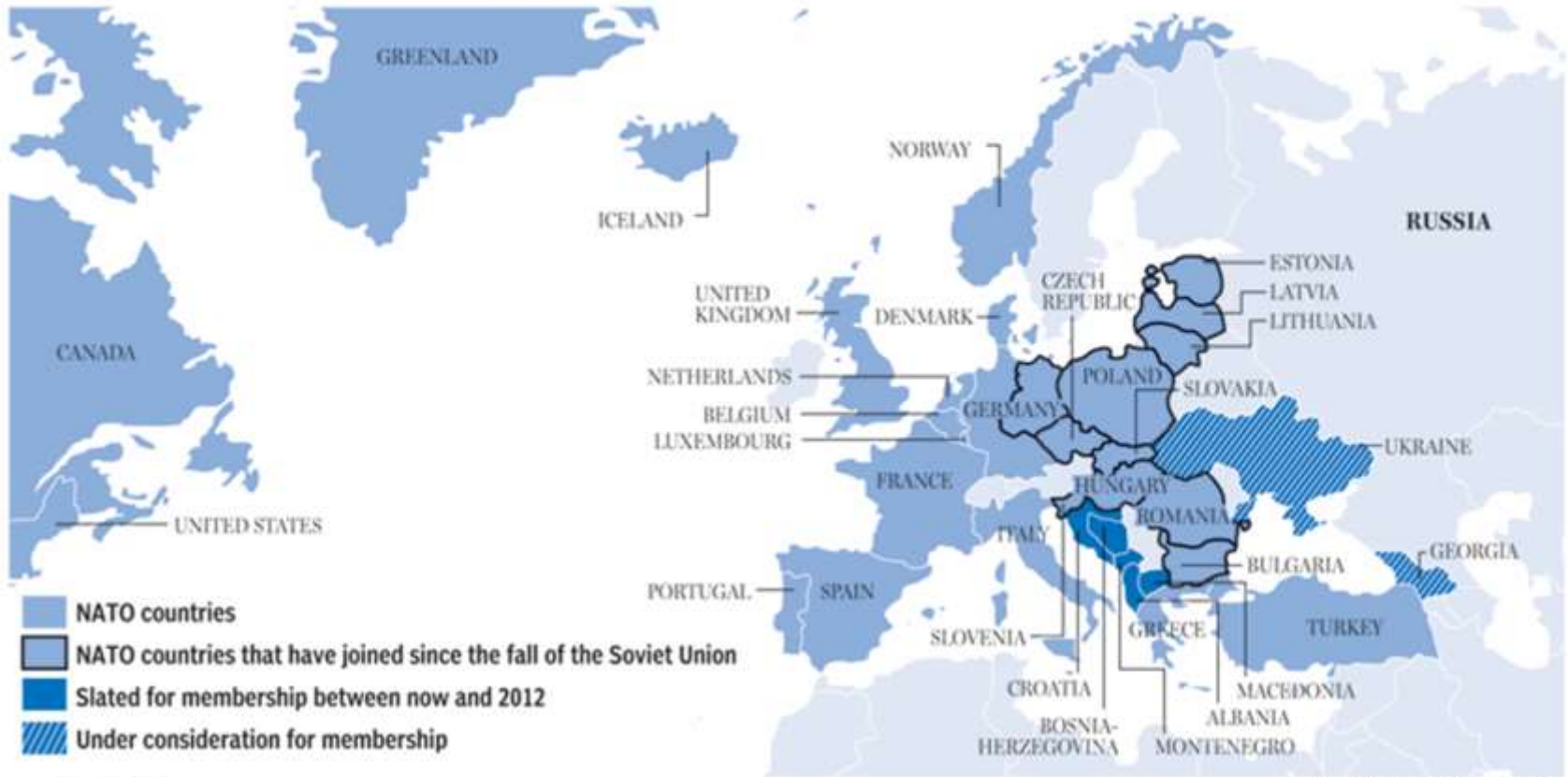

Himalayan Battling Worsens

New Front Opened By Chinese Reds

NEW DELHI, Oct. 22—The battle in the Himalayas grew grimmer Monday as the Chinese Communists opened a new front against Indians near the Burma border, brought in tanks in Ladakh and advanced further into Indian territory near Srinagar.

Five more Indian military posts fell to the Chinese on the third day of continuous savage fighting between Indian and Communist troops.

Meanwhile, Prime Minister Nehru in a broadcast message to the nation Monday night said:

"The time has come for us to realize fully this menace that threatens the freedom of our people and the independence of your country."

Nehru attacked the Chinese in vehement terms. He charged that the Chinese were "so powerful and unscrupulous aggressors, not caring for peace or peaceful methods."

"We must build up our arms."

The President And Cuba

(An Editorial)

The distinctive feature of President Kennedy's address to the nation concerning the development of intermediate and long-range missile sites in Cuba, is that it represents a determined and uncompromising effort to persuade the Soviet Union to abandon its military threat in Cuba.

If the Soviet starts to haggle about it, our Navy will proceed to stop all shipping entering Cuban waters, and seize all munitions it might find on such ships. Such a blockade is an act of war. It will affect our Allies, just as it will affect the Soviet Union.

The President is to be commended for acting with such firm decision, because, as he remarked, the Soviet threat has become so imminent 92 miles off our coast, that failure to act would probably lead to much expanded Soviet buildup.

The President's action and his words leave the gate wide open for the Soviets to withdraw, and thus still leave Cuba as a Communist satellite. The chances are that they will fulminate and threaten. They may be foolish enough to launch a full-scale war; but there again, the chances are that once they see that the President and our nation are determined to remove the missile threat from Cuba, they may have the good sense to withdraw. It may be a slow operation, but eventually they know they will have to get out.

It is doubtful that the Soviets will risk nuclear war. They know that in a few days we could reduce their country to a desert of destruction. We are much more powerful than they are. Their people abhor

Air Force, Navy Men Hopping

Planes And Warships Busy In Florida Area

KEY WEST, Fla., Oct. 22 (AP)—Military activity in Florida built to a crest pitch Monday as President Kennedy announced the institution of a naval blockade of Cuba, just 90 miles away.

Fighter planes rushed to Patrick Air Force Base, but the briefing there was the planes were not to protect Cape Canaveral but to be ready for deployment in the Caribbean if necessary.

Nearly every Navy vessel steamed out of harbors at Jacksonville and Key West, apparently for the blockade. Key West located in the Defense Department looked up air power in that area.

The Air Force built up a force of 36 F106 and F104 fighter interceptor jet planes at Patrick and erected a tent city beside the runway for personnel.

The planes, equipped with sidewinder air-to-air and other unidentifiable rockets, were parked on alert status, with cockpits open, ladders up the side and an auxiliary power unit under each for fast start. Through the day, the jets

President Says Soviet Lied, Castro Missile Bases For Offense

Washington, Oct. 22 (AP)—President Kennedy put into effect a U.S. blockade of Cuba Monday night, after disclosing that the Soviets are shipping into Cuba long-range weapons able to rain nuclear destruction on all the Americas.

Kennedy spoke in a grim emergency nationwide radio-television address in which he disclosed that, despite past Soviet assurances to the contrary, offensive atomic missiles sites are being built in Cuba and Soviet jet bombers capable of carrying nuclear weapons have arrived there.

Kennedy outlined a 7-point program for fast military and diplomatic action to stop Cuba from being built up as a Communist launching base against the hemisphere and sent a letter to Soviet Premier Khrushchev calling for a halt.

Speedy developments amid an atmosphere of deep crisis followed the President's somber announcement:

—A Defense Department spokesman said the United States is ready to sink every Communist bloc ship headed for Cuba which refuses to stop for a search. The blockade, which could apply against planes later, applies against offensive weapons but not nonmilitary necessities like food or medicine.

—The Navy said at San Juan, Puerto Rico, that the more than 40 ships and 20,000 men assembled for announced annual Caribbean exercises now are "sustaining the blockade" of Cuba.

This has been the political, geographical and diplomatic equivalent of the **Cuban Missile Crisis** in 1962, when the Soviet Union attempted to establish military bases in Cuba that could threaten America.

Abusing Ukraine as a Political Football

KYIV Explosions at Sam rock airports in Kyiv and nearby Boryspil and Gostyni. 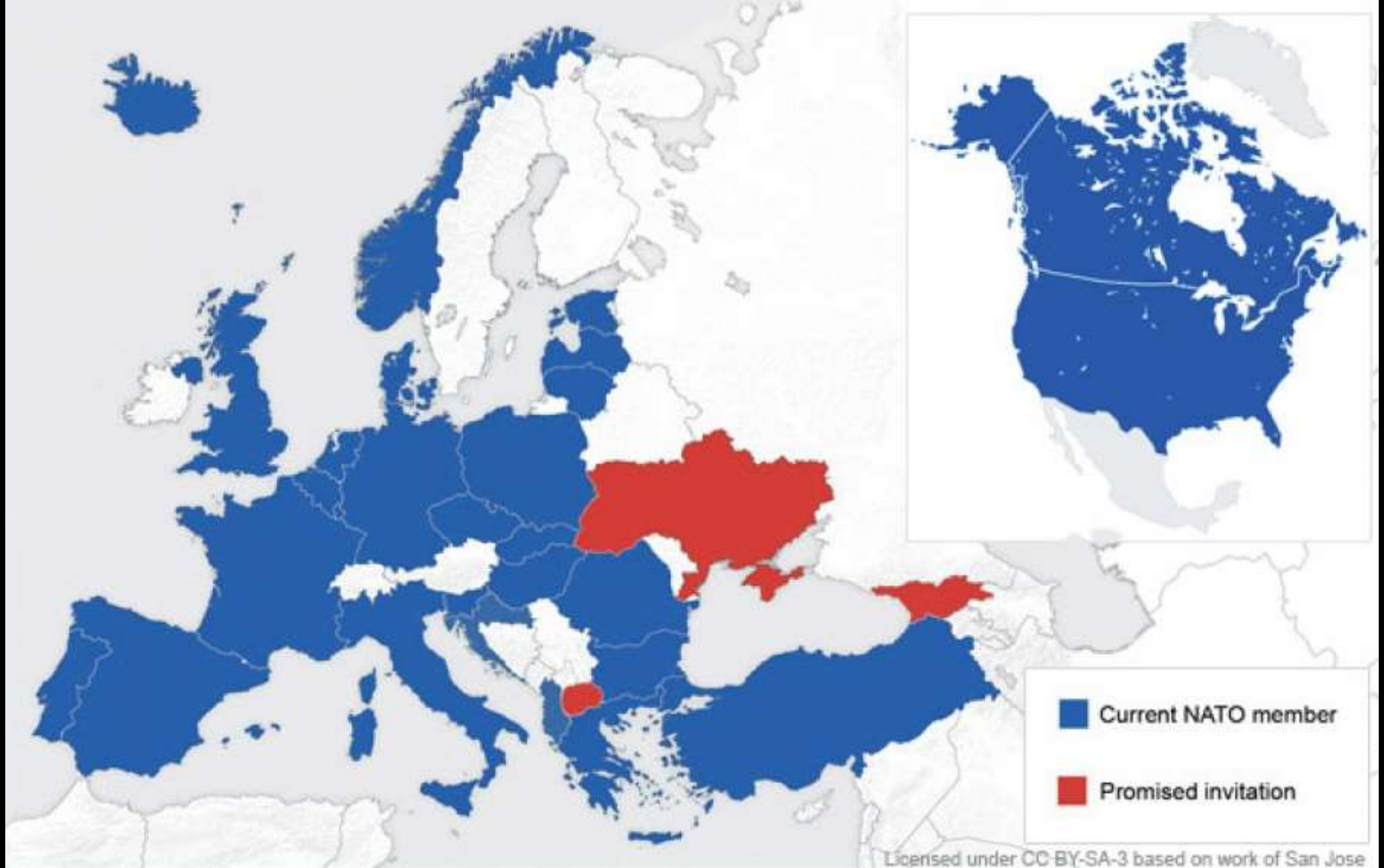

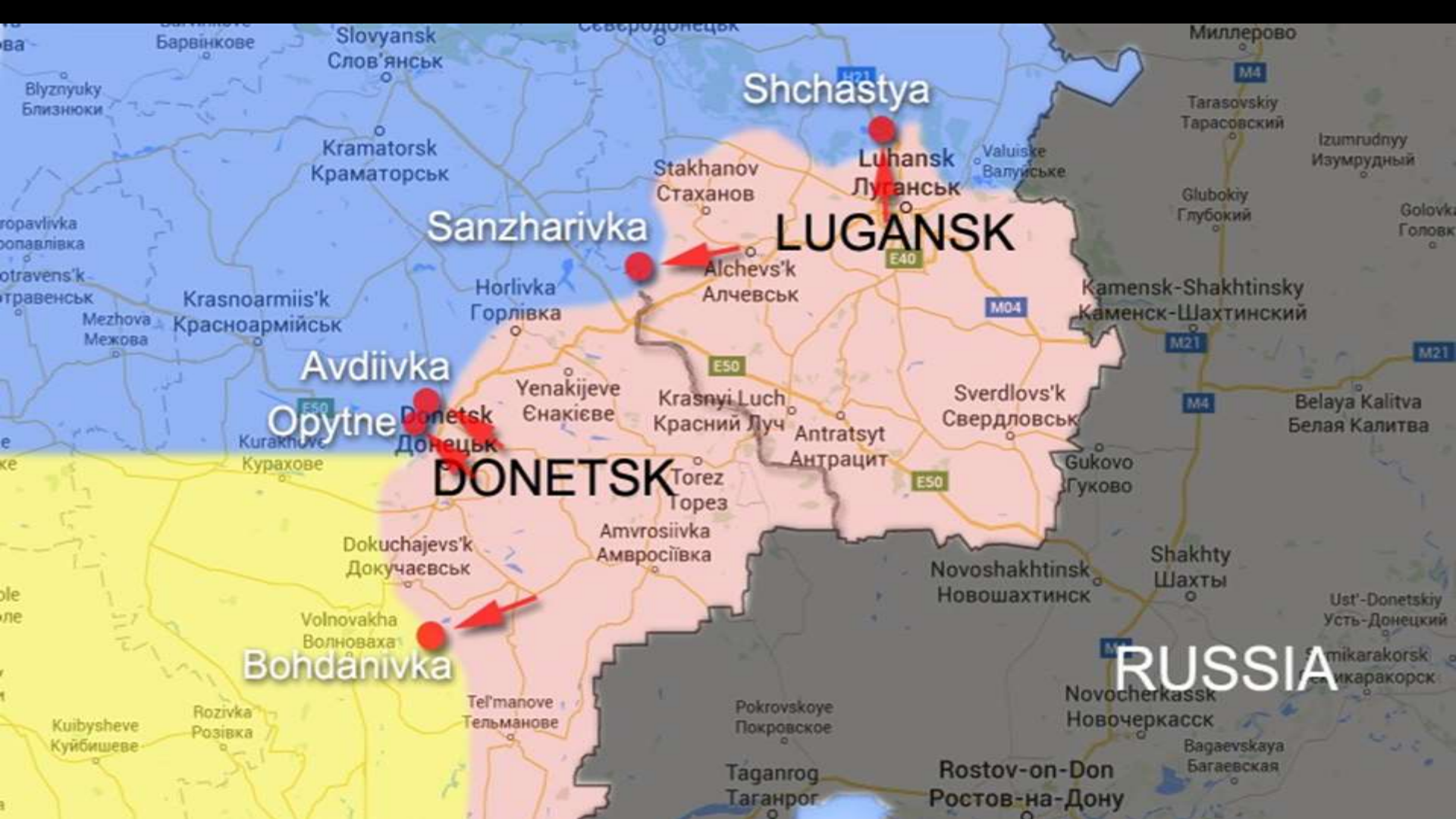

The Eastern Front - 2014

The head of Ukraine's national security council said Russia had close to 100,000 troops along Ukraine's borders in the north, south, and east. Western experts believe the number of Russian forces near eastern and southern Ukraine is close to 30,000 to 45,000.



This triggered a civil war which led to a ceasefire in August 2014



and the boundaries being recognised by the **Treaty of Minsk** in 2015.

The Refusal to Give Non-nuclear Guarantees



When Biden rejected Russia's demand for a promise that Ukraine would not become a base for anti-Russian nuclear missiles,



Putin's predictable decision was to formally recognize Donetsk and Luhansk as independent countries and to enter into mutual defence agreements.
